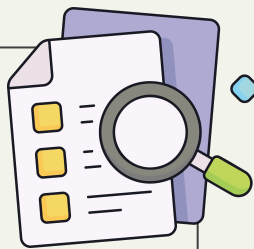

- To identify effective practices, and inform MOE's curriculum decisions

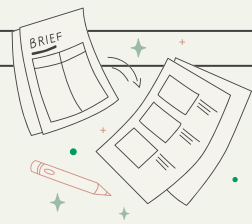
What you can provide:

Surveys: Online, from all participating students, and ALL teachers

Lesson Access: For lesson video recording, focusing on teaching practice.

Student Artefacts: Marked work and/or SLS uploads from selected students.

What we need from you:

Teacher Participation

- **ALL** P5, S1, S3 teachers for the respective surveys
- Selected teachers for lesson recordings and interviews.

Consent Dissemination

- Help to circulate parental consent via the Parents Gateway

Flexible Scheduling

- Lesson access across 1-2 terms, on a schedule that fits your school's calendar

Time Commitment

- ~7-16 hours per teacher
 - ~3-5 hours per student
- Over 1-3 months

Data - confidentiality and anonymity

- Data stored on a password-protected NIE server, inaccessible outside NIE
